Stephen: We inspire people with the stories and scriptures of answered prayer, train them in the fundamental locks and keys of effective prayer, then we give them 6 different tools they can use to help them pray.

What scripture was the catalyst for the project?

Alex: In Matthew 6:6, Jesus teaches us to go into our inner room and to pray to our Father in secret. Then, God rewards what is done in secret. So He desires for us to draw closer to Him in our secret place, and not just when people are watching us.

Stephen: Matthew 6:6, James 5:16, Colossians 4:2, and 1 Timothy 2:1-5.

How has creating *War Room* the movie and the book projects impacted your prayer life?

Alex: The more we study prayer, the more we are driven to make it a larger part of our life. It's meant to go along with the Word of God in maturing us in our faith and making us bold in our calling. Both Stephen and myself have

increased our time with the Lord in prayer. We're also helping our families to do the same thing. We want to be warriors ready for His orders, not lukewarm believers that spend most of our time on the bench.

Stephen: I have learned much more about prayer and have truly been inspired and challenged working on this movie and book. It has caused me to pray more joyfully, specifically, and with a greater faith—trusting that my Heavenly Father will answer in His timing.


