# GREG LAURIE

LIVE FOR CHRIST NOW TO PREPARE FOR THE FUTURE



For Christians, the belief of an eternal life in Heaven is a basic tenet of the faith. But how does that belief affect living one's life right now? For bestselling author and Harvest Christian Fellowship Senior Pastor Greg Laurie, a devastating loss prompted a search for answers. In *As It Is in Heaven*, Laurie explores how Heaven can make a difference in believers' lives here on Earth.

**There are currently thousands of books available in the marketplace on the topic of Heaven. Can you share with readers why your approach to the subject is different?**

Most books about Heaven try to get us to Heaven, but they seem to be lacking a little bit in getting us back home. This one, I hope, will get you to think about how Heaven makes a difference for our life on Earth—right here, right now. The title gives it away, I think: *As It Is in Heaven: How Eternity Brings Focus to What Really Matters*. The unique angle of this book is that what goes on in Heaven can really provide us with practical direction and inspiration right now. I have found that those who think the most of the next life do the most for this one.

The Bible tells us to set our affections on things above (see Colossians 3). Another way to translate this is, "Think Heaven!" Our minds should be in Heaven, but our feet must be on this earth.

**You offer advice and scriptural guidance in the book for those in mourning. Can you speak a bit about the loss of your son and how his death led you to be a lot more interested in Heaven and encouraged you to learn about and develop that "sure hope?"**

Our first son, Christopher, was precocious, always getting into trouble—but we always loved him with all of our hearts, and he knew it. In his twenties, he rebelled against



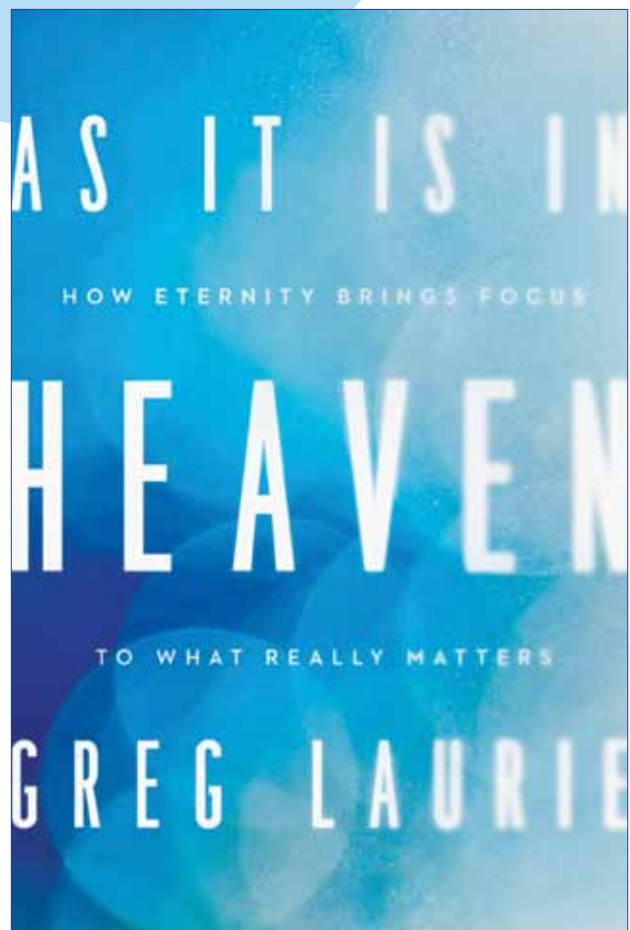
the Lord. So we prayed and endured many sleepless nights. And then God got a hold of Christopher, and he made a recommitment to Christ. He got married to a wonderful girl named Brittany, and they gave us two wonderful granddaughters.

On July 24, 2008, Cathe and I were both at home. Cathe was doing a Bible study with Brittany and her mom. We hadn't heard from Christopher. He was on his way to our church, where he worked. We tried to call him. He didn't answer. So I texted him: "Where are you?" There was no answer. We soon found out why: my son left this world around 9:01 A.M. in an automobile crash.

When I heard the horrific news that I would never see my son again on this earth, time just stopped. I went into an immediate state of shock. I fell on the floor, and cried out to God for help—not to get through the day, but through the minutes. It was a nightmare from which I kept hoping I would wake. It has been five years since that terrible day. I am still mourning. It still hurts. Is the sorrow still as deep as it was in the immediate aftermath of Christopher dying? No. It isn't. It is different. Is it better? In a way. We have received the Lord's comfort in so many ways and I have learned about hope—and I have the hope of Heaven. It is actually more real than it has ever been for me. When I get depressed thinking about Christopher, I will effectively preach to myself, saying something like, "Greg, you listen to me. The Bible says you will see your son again. He is in Heaven. And the Bible says that Jesus is the resurrection and the life and he that believes in Him will not die."

I am not an expert on Heaven, but I am a student of it. I have sought to know everything I can about the future destination of all those who put their faith in Jesus Christ.

Statistics show that 69 percent of Americans believe in the existence of angels, and in the book, you point out that most Americans have picked up their impressions about angels from the entertainment industry. Could you share with us some of the significant distortions you feel that Hollywood has made with regard to angels and Heaven? Are there any particular films or

#### television shows that get it right?

Many believe that when we die, we become angels. This is simply not biblical. Angels are magnificent created beings that do His work. The Bible tells us that they sometimes guide us, other times protect us, and are sent as "ministering spirits" to us in this life (Hebrews 1:14). Then when life comes to an end, the angels give us a personal escort to heaven (see Luke 16:22).

Having stated this, we must not pray to angels or become overly preoccupied with them. They are, as Billy Graham once said, "God's secret agents" doing His bidding. They would never want us to make them the center of attention. They would want us to give our worship to God alone.

I honestly cannot think of any movie or TV program that I have ever seen that really captures how angels work in our lives today. But of course, I have not seen all the movies or TV shows about them.

**There is often some confusion between the Rapture and the Second Coming, and you point out the important differences between the two. Do you have some advice for those who are not yet prepared for these events?**

In the Rapture, Jesus comes for His church. In the Second Coming, Jesus comes with His church. The Rapture is before the great tribulation coming upon the whole world. The Second Coming of Christ is at the end of the tribulation.

I would advise any person who has not yet put their faith in Christ to do so immediately. Jesus said that He was coming for those who are watching and waiting.

Hebrew 9:28 tells us, “Christ died once for all time as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. He will come again, not to deal with our sins, but to bring salvation to all who are eagerly waiting for Him.”

**Could you share with us exactly what Harvest America is and how this relates to the message of *As It Is in Heaven*?**

Harvest America is an annual live nationwide event, streamed from a single location to thousands of participating locations across the country—including churches, theaters, businesses, and living rooms. Featuring performances by top Christian artists and a clear gospel message that I give, the goal of Harvest America is to impact a nation desperately in need of hope. So far, we have already had half a million people in live attendance in the last two years, with thousands making professions of faith to follow Jesus Christ. **What's next for you?**

My next big project is a new book on Revelation, with the title of *The Next Dimension*. It is a commentary on the entire book of Revelation and I am very excited about it. It will be quite large and comprehensive and we have been working on it for two years. After that I am working on a book on the prophet Jonah. Another project I'm excited about is a compilation of all the crusade sermons I have preached over the last 25 years to millions around the world. **INGRAM**
