Under the Same Stars



Bray is the #1 New York Times-bestselling author of The Gemma Doyle trilogy (A Great and Terrible Beauty, Rebel Angels, The Sweet Far Thing); the Michael L. Printz Award-winning Going Bovine; Beauty Queens, an L.A. Times Book Prize finalist; and The Diviners series. She is originally from Texas but makes her home in New York City.

I've been moved and inspired by the stories of young people who speak out, march, protest, and put themselves at risk in order to bring about change...

Bray makes her Macmillan debut with this standalone YA novel that explores the cyclical nature of fascism and genocide—and how teens have always been part of the resistance against it. In this propulsive historical mystery, three timelines converge to unveil the truth behind the disappearance of two girls during World War II.

An Interview with the Author

Under the Same Stars is a mystery that unravels across three timelines: 1940s Germany, 1980s Germany, and 2020 New York. How did you land on these moments in history?

There is a Mark Twain saying: "History doesn't repeat itself, but it often rhymes." When I began writing the novel, I was concerned about the rise of hate crimes and authoritarianism at home and around the world. It seemed not a coincidence that much of this "rhyming" was happening as we were losing the World War II generation; the living witnesses of that history. The Bridegroom's Oak, the tree that links the three storylines, is in northern Germany so it made sense to start with WWII. I'm also a huge David Bowie fan. "Heroes" is among my favorite songs and it's about two lovers separated by the Berlin Wall. That piece took me to 1980. Finally, in one of my true nerd moments, I'd read about the mycorrhizal network the vast underground system of "fungal threads" that connect trees and help them communicate and share resources. I thought about history and how these various,

wide-ranging threads, these stories from the past, are connected to the present. I decided the novel needed to be structured as its own mycorrhizal network with each narrative informing the others, inextricably linked as we all are. History is never really past; we carry it with us.

The role of teenagers in resistance movements throughout history is a core theme of the novel. Why was that important to you to explore?

Young people inherit the world, and they want that world to be better, fairer, more just. They are not afraid to ask questions like, "Why is this happening? Who does this benefit? What if we imagined a different way?" They are willing to call out hypocrisy and injustice. I've been moved and inspired by the stories of young people who speak out, march, protest, and put themselves at risk in order to bring about change: the Parkland students, who have been voices for aun control: climate activist Greta Thunbera: human rights advocate Malala Yousafzai; and going back further, Sophie Scholl and the student-led White Rose movement who rebelled against the Third Reich, and the punks of East Berlin who could have faced prison time simply for making music critical of the government. My experience in talking with young people is that they will call out B.S. but they are not cynical and nihilistic. They believe that systemic change is possible, and they are willing to do the work.

You've delved into the 1890s with the Gemma Doyle trilogy, and the 1920s with The Diviners series. How did your research and writing approach differ (or not!) when immersing us in the '40s and '80s?

Apparently, I'm a glutton for punishment! I love history and learning, so research is a way to indulge both interests. What's always surprising to me is how one thing is connected to another. You might think, "I just need to know this one particular detail about Germany in 1939," but then you realize that in order to *truly* understand, you have to go back to Weimar Germany and inflation and then further back to Germany's defeat in World War I. Then you need cultural understanding; you need lots of context.

The writing experience, however, was quite a new one for me. I have a very disorganized, free-range mind—a "pantser" not a "plotter." But because this was a mystery with interconnected timelines, I needed to "see" the story. So, I mapped the whole thing out in a 25K-word synopsis. And then I thought, "I HAVE FIGURED OUT THIS WRITING THING FOREVER!" Haha...ha. Nope. Working on a new book right now and I don't have a clue. In the immortal words of Han Solo, "Don't get cocky, kid."

How did you settle on your approach to the magical realism within the novel?

That was a real challenge for me! I've written fantasy, supernatural, absurdist/surrealist/trippy things and my default is toward the weird and skewed. That said, the Bridegroom's Oak feels magical because it's a matchmaking tree! (Instead of "Tinder" can we call it "Timber?" I'll show myself out.) Anyway, to me, that conferred an automatic fairy-tale feeling so I ran with it. I loved fairy tales when I was young, the bloodier the better. ("She was an...interesting child," they all said.) I kept thinking about Bruno Bettleheim's The Uses of Enchantment: The Meaning and Importance of Fairy Tales and the ways in which fairy tales can help children come to terms with some of life's harsher truths as well as their own unconscious aggression, those monsters inside that must be acknowledged. In a way, history can feel like a fairy tale. It's something that must be told again and again in order to make sense of our human story so that we might learn and, hopefully, grow from it.

What do you hope readers take away from *Under the* Same Stars?

My first hope, always, is that readers will be swept up in the story itself. That it will be an enjoyable reading experience with characters they truly care about. But beyond that, it would be lovely if readers walked away with a renewed sense of hope for the future and a commitment to making that hope active voice. I say that this is a book about love and resistance—love as an act of resistance and resistance as an act of love. It's a story about ordinary people abandoning their denial and putting aside personal comfort in order to do what they feel is moral and just and humane. We all have that capacity, that story within us. It isn't always as dramatic as helping people escape death. It can be planting small but necessary seeds: registering voters, volunteering at a soup kitchen, speaking up for someone who needs an ally. All have merit. All count. As they say, no one can do everything, but everyone can do something. INGRAM
