JOANNA HO, CAROLINE KUSIN PRITCHARD, & DAN SANTAT

The Day the Books Disappeared

CELEBRATING THE POWER OF BOOKS



All-star authors Ho (*Eyes That Kiss in the Corners*) and Pritchard (*The Keeper of Stories*) team up with Caldecott Medalist and National Book Award winner Santat in this celebration of the freedom to read.

Ho is the award-winning and *New York Times*-bestselling author of many children's books, including *Eyes That Kiss in the Corners*, *We Who Produce Pearls*, and *The Silence That Binds Us*, her debut young adult novel, which received the Young Adult Honor for the Asian/Pacific American Award for Literature. Her passion for equity in books and education is matched only by her love of homemade chocolate chip cookies, outdoor adventures, and dance parties with her kids.

Pritchard is the author of *Gitty and Kvetch* and *Where Is Poppy?*, which *School Library Journal* called "a perfect story for all ages." She has an MFA in writing for children and young adults from Vermont College of Fine Arts and lives in Virginia with her family.

Santat is the National Book Award-winning, Caldecott Medal-winning, and *New York Times*-bestselling author and illustrator of *The Adventures of Beekle: The Unimaginary Friend* and the road trip/time travel adventure *Are We There Yet?* His artwork is also featured in numerous picture books, chapter books, and middle-grade novels, including Dav Pilkey's Ricky Ricotta series. Santat lives in Southern California with his wife, two kids, and many, many pets.

What was the inspiration for *The Day the Books Disappeared*?

Joanna/Caroline: The rise of book banning and censorship across the nation in recent years has been alarming and harmful for students, educators, librarians, and creatives, not to mention society at large. As creatives and educators, we have seen the powerful impact of stories and books, as well as the devastating consequences of efforts to remove and restrict access to books. We wanted to write a story that humanized these impacts for young readers to understand. It was important for us to be honest about these big ideas while staying true to the joy, humor, and heart of this specific story.

What appealed to you about illustrating this book?

Dan: In my 20+ years in publishing I will get manuscripts that I think will be fun to do and manuscripts that I feel like I need to do because the message is so important. Joanna and Caroline have written a manuscript that provided both. When I first read the script, it hit the nail on the head about the damage that book banning can do but presented it in a way that kids can easily comprehend, and I also get to draw airplanes. Lots and lots of airplanes.

What do you hope kids—and adults—take away from the story?

Joanna/Caroline: We hope that this book inspires young people and adults alike to be curious—to open themselves to perspectives, beliefs and experiences that initially seem to differ from their own. This is the power of story. Most Americans are against book banning; we hope this book inspires readers to learn more and join in the fight for our freedom to read and our freedom to write.

Dan: Obviously, it's a metaphor about book banning. I hope everyone understands that this world means nothing if we can't share everything.

What was your favorite topic to read about when you were a child?

Joanna: If it was in a book, I wanted to read it! I loved to read everything, from fantasy novels by Lawrence Yep, to the Hardy Boys, to *Calvin and Hobbes*, to books about racehorses and friendly bears and boarding schools. Reading opened worlds to me, and I hope we can do that for readers today.

Caroline: Joanna and I have this in common! I read *Harriet the Spy*, *Hershel and the Hanukkah Goblins*, *Archie* comics, and everything in between. The topic was less important to me than the magic of transporting into a world outside my own experience.

Dan: I was a big comic book nerd. It was my soap opera every month and it also helped me teach myself how to draw and inspired me to be a better artist.

The last line of the book is: “Squished between friends, sharing their favorite books, became their all-time favorite thing to do.” **Do you have an all-time favorite thing to do?**

Joanna: I have many all-time favorite things to do! One of them is reading. Give me some comfy sweats, some homemade cookies, and good book, and I could read for days in complete contentment and happiness. I also love to tromp outside on camping trips and hiking adventures with my family. The natural world is a wonder and treasure!

Caroline: Nothing beats watching our four kids dream up an imagined world and live inside it together. But second place is taking myself on a solo date with a book and, rather than reading it, listening in on the conversations happening all around me. I mean this in the least creepy way possible! It’s been a master class for honing my observation and character-building skills. Similar to reading a book, there’s something about beholding the rich experiences of strangers that gets me out of my own head and into the wonder and weirdness of our shared human experience.

Dan: It’s funny you ask that question because just the other day my son came to my studio and asked me what I did for fun and I paused for a moment realizing that he’s never seen me just sit and play a video game (like I used to for hours on end) and that most of my time has just been sitting in the studio making art and writing, so I guess to answer your question it would be making books. **INGRAM**
