Ruby Bridges: A Talk with My Teacher

Bridges is a civil rights icon, activist, author, and speaker who, at the age of six, was the first Black student to integrate William Frantz Elementary, an all-white elementary school in Louisiana. Bridges is the recipient of numerous awards, including the NAACP Martin Luther

King Award and the Presidential Citizens Medal, and she has received honorary doctorate degrees from Connecticut College; College of New Rochelle; Teachers College, Columbia University; and Tulane University. In 2024, Bridges was inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame. Bridges is also the author of I Am Ruby Bridges, Through My Eyes, This Is Your Time, and Dear Ruby, Hear Our Hearts. Tell us about your new book, Ruby Bridges: A Talk with My Teacher.


When I was only six years old, I was the first Black child to integrate William Frantz Elementary School. I became best friends with my first-grade teacher, Mrs. Henry. I was excited to come back for the second year but was devastated to learn that Mrs. Henry wouldn't be my second-grade teacher. This story is a love letter to all teachers who hold the power to change lives and shows the lasting impact that the best of teachers can have on the lives of their students.

What Inspired you to write A Talk with My Teacher?

A Talk with My Teacher was inspired by memories of the year I spent alone with Barbara Henry, my first-grade teacher, and writing it is my way to honor her and all teachers. She profoundly affected my life at the time and helped shape me to become the person I am today.

What do you hope that readers will take away from this story? My hope is that sharing my memories with you will stir your own memories of a certain teacher who may have been in your life or inspire appreciation for what a special teacher can do to mold who you will become. After all, teachers today are the first responders in the lives of their students, our babies. And even though I know it is the noblest of professions, teachers are not honored nearly enough or appreciated as such. This story is indeed meant to be a tribute, not just to Mrs. Henry—the teacher of whom I am most fond—but a tribute to all teachers who have chosen to shape the lives of children, including this country's future leaders.

My hope is that sharing my memories with you will stiryour own memories of a certain teacher who may have been in your life...
