

# The Power of Print on Demand and Wholesale Distribution

With wholesale distribution linked to print on demand (POD), you can make your books available to bookstores and online retailers from around the world. Both Lightning Source® and IngramSpark® use Ingram Book Group LLC ("Ingram Book") as one way of connecting your content to 40,000 retailers and libraries. Whether stores and libraries are traditional brick-and-mortar entities or live entirely online, sell printed or eBooks- they can purchase wholesale from Ingram.

Publishers who use POD directly integrated with wholesale distribution enjoy seamless and inexpensive global book distribution. With no inventory on hand, books are printed on demand and distributed (eBooks) as retailers place orders. As the publisher, you are paid minus the cost of printing (POD only) and the wholesale discount, which eliminates the high up-front costs associated with physical stock. This makes it easier than ever before to build your independent global publishing business. However, in order to build a global business, you first need to understand how retailers order books. In the following pages we will demystify this process whilst highlighting the importance of pricing your titles in all available currencies.





# How Do Retailers Order Books from Ingram Book?

The above diagram demonstrates the variety of paths by which your titles and metadata can reach retailers around the world. Most orders come via Ingram Book Group LLC ("Ingram Book") which connects to over 40,000 retailers and libraries globally. Enabling your titles through Lightning Source® or IngramSpark® and pricing them in USD makes them available via Ingram Book. As a global wholesaler based in North America, Ingram Book is the dominant wholesaler in its local market with most bookstores who operate within that region ordering directly from Ingram Book.

# Other Ways Retailers Order Books

Most retailers prefer to buy from wholesalers rather than trade directly with each individual publisher but not all retailers buy directly from Ingram Book. Consequently, Lightning Source UK Ltd ("Lightning Source UK") supplies other global wholesalers too, further strengthening your titles global reach. We do this because not one wholesaler controls the market and whilst all wholesales operate globally, some are stronger in certain regions than others.

This is not intended as a complete list, but with the addition of Ingram Book, these wholesalers supply a large portion of booksellers worldwide. This illustrates why you should price your titles in as many markets as possible – you never know where in the world your next customer might be.

### **Fact**

Publishers who price their titles globally, on average, sell over 25% more books than those with pricing gaps.

Both Lightning Source® and IngramSpark® allow you to price in GBP, USD, Euros and Australian Dollars. We strongly recommend that you price your titles in all available markets to ensure you never miss a sale.



# The Role of Lightning Source

Retailers typically prefer to order via multiple methods, and we support this by enabling retailers to buy directly from Lightning Source UK and Lightning Source Australia Pty Limited. This doesn't preclude sales from Ingram Book, it simply provides bookshops with more options to order your titles. As an example, some bookshops only buy books in their own currency, so you maximize your opportunity for sales by pricing globally.


