What is Global Connect?

Global Connect helps publishers reach more countries by using local Print-on-Demand (POD) printers who have established relationships with booksellers in their markets. This complements Ingram's existing reach from the USA, UK, Australia, France, and Sharjah by adding 11 more markets. Through Global Connect, distributors use POD technology to fulfil demand, helping ensure books are supplied closer to both the reader and bookseller. Covering nearly 50% of the world's population, Global Connect reaches more booksellers worldwide.

Global Connect FAQs

How do I sign up for Global Connect?

The Global Connect program is part of your Global Agreement, if you have signed a Global Agreement, you can already enable your titles for Global Connect. Otherwise, you can click on the 'Quick Link' tab on your web dashboard marked 'Global Connect Markets'.

How do I add my titles to the Global Connect markets?

By entering a retail price and wholesale discount for each title and each market, Ingram will make your titles available in each current Global Connect market. Pricing provided against a Global Connect market will serve as your permission to distribute the title in that market through Global Connect.

How do I set pricing for my books in different global markets?

Global Connect transacts globally in US Dollars, therefore you provide pricing and discounts for each Global Connect market in USD. This ensures you do not have to calculate multiple currencies and exchange rates. The price information is sent with your books metadata to the Global Connect networks, and they handle the local retail pricing and distribution.

Who determines the retail price?

The Global Connect printer will convert your US Dollar wholesale price into their country's currency. They also factor in their own margin and printing costs to finally determine the selling price for the book for their local market.

Where are the books printed for Global Connect?

Global Connect utilises 11 international POD printers, across Europe, Asia plus South Africa, and Brazil. They all have connections to sales channels, and print your books in the country where the order originated.

How long will it take for a book to be delivered to a reader?

Delivery times can vary but using Global Connect ensures that books reach international readers much faster, often within days rather than weeks due to books being printed in market.

Are the books returnable?

No, all sales are non-returnable through Global Connect.

How do I get paid for book sales?

Every sale made through Global Connect are reported on your account, and payments are made to the publisher 90 days from the end of the month in which the sales are received and reported.

What currency will I be paid in?

All payments to the publisher are calculated in US Dollars and reported out of the US. However, we can pay your sales revenue in the currency you request. The payment currencies supported today are USD, GBP, AUD, EUR.

How often do I receive reporting?

We provide sales reports for Global Connect sales monthly within the existing US POD publisher compensation statements. You can also generate reports from your account. This can be found under Reports, then Compensation. Select the option for the Global Connect Compensation.

How does Ingram Lightning Source ensure safety of publisher files with the Global Connect printer?

Ingram Lightning Source performs due diligence on all Global Connect printers and ensures they have a strict IT security infrastructure and internal security policies are implemented. Publisher's print files are sent to Global Connect printers over industry standard encrypted network connections, plus all files are deleted after 7-10 days from the printer server.

Are all the Global Connect printers FSC certified?

Each Global Connect printer complies with current environmental and sustainable policies. They source paper from FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) certified Paper Mills and print on FSC paper or PEFC (Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification) paper.

Are all Lightning Source POD Book Types and Trim Sizes available from Global Connect printers?

Ingram Lightning Source ensures that over 95% of Book Types and Trim Sizes can be printed in the Global Connect countries. All printers are capable of manufacturing the majority of standard sized trim sizes, and product types, whether in B&W or Colour, Paperback or Hardback.
